Selected reading and Theme: Luke 24:36b-48

'You are witnesses of these things.'

Discipleship Thought: One theme of our text for this week is how one distinguishes between reality and fiction, truth and lies. For the disciples of Jesus, this was a life and death question. They had staked their lives on the truth of who Jesus was and the message he preached. Now he was dead, thanks to lies and trumped—up charges. How were they to determine who or what stood before them now? What is true and what is lies is a crucial question in our time when counterfeit realities surround us. Jesus's antidote to lies and unreality is touching and seeing. What does this mean in practice for us as communities of faith? How do we touch and see to determine truth? And how do we do this together and not just as individuals?

Prayer: God of love, we thank you for the words of scripture that tell us:

'See what love the Father has given us, that we should be called children of God.'

We thank you that nothing that we do can change this fundamental, creational truth.

We thank you that from the beginning of everything you made us in your image.

We thank you that at the moment of creation,
