Selected Reading: Psalm 79:1-9 - Called to pray, even for the enemy

Discipleship Thought: The psalms offer words for a range of emotions. Reading Psalm 79 might stir up in us righteous anger and a desire to punish others we see as responsible. However, if we look at it another way, this might be read as an indictment of Christian communities that have failed to look after each other and the vulnerable in their midst. When put in contrast with the words of the epistle reading, we might feel a little sheepish. The writer of 1 Timothy reminds us that God wants all people to be saved, in contrast to the psalmist, who is calling for the enemy to be destroyed.

In a world where grief can harden into anger and justice can become vengeance, God calls us to a deeper response: to pray, even for those who have wronged us, trusting in a mercy that reaches farther than our pain. Let us heed the call to pray for all people.

Prayer: Gracious God, may your glory shine in this place, calling us into your radiant presence, filling us with your loving-kindness.

Loving God, may your mercy fill this space, calling us into gratitude and forgiveness, filling us with your peace.


