Selected Reading: Luke 14:1, 7–14 - Humility, hospitality, and the image of God

**Discipleship Thought:** The readings today encourage us to see ourselves and others with the right amount of respect. In Luke 14:1, 7–14, the reader is cautioned not to think of themselves too highly at a wedding banquet. Hebrews 13:1–8, 15–16 similarly talks about inviting guests over, the treatment of prisoners and others who are marginalised. Human society often has hierarchies that value some people over others, but these readings encourage us to rethink those hierarchies.

The way we treat others is a visible demonstration of the kind of people we are. The way we think of ourselves is important, too. In Genesis, we are told that each person is made in the image of God. What might it mean to see the image of God in each and every person we meet? Through humility, hospitality, and recognising the image of God in every person, we reflect the very heart of Christ's call to discipleship.


